Moodle is a teaching-learning online platform, where your teachers can:

As a student, you can also use this platform to:

- Communicate with your teachers;
- Download your class materials;
- Submit your homework or group work.

How to access Moodle!

1. Go to ISCAP's website or just type:

https://online.iscap.ipp.pt/ano201920/

2. The first thing that you can do is to change the language of the platform (top left corner)



3. After that, on the upper right corner, login with your ISCAP's credentials.




Example:

Username: 120 0000 (Student number)
Password: rmD4G7E (request Help Desk*)

* in case you forgot or lost your username/password (office 128, 1st floor).

You are now logged in the Moodle platform. Notice that your name appears at the top right corner of the page:



4. The next step is finding your courses. To do that, please go to "Site Home" in order to check all the courses available.



5. After that, you can use the search box that is in the middle of the page to write the **name of the course** or the **name of the teacher** you are looking for.



6. When you find the course you need, it's necessary to click on it and then confirm that you wish to enrol that course pressing "Enrol me".



When you enter the course you can see and use everything your teacher has prepared for you.
